**JOB SUMMARY**

Under supervision of head guard. Required to safeguard wading pool patrons and ensure proper use of wading pool and facilities. Other duties include maintenance of the pool and surrounding areas.

**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- **Is considered a first responder for all medical emergency procedures and may be exposed to possible health risks.** *Including cleaning and supervision of aquatic facility*
- Supervises aquatic facility
- Enforces all facility rules and regulations
- Maintains pool records and paperwork
- Ability to detect potential or actual emergency conditions and handle them safely and effectively
- Ability to foster good public relations with the local public
- Must be able to instruct learn to swim program

**JOB QUALIFICATIONS**

- 17 years of age or older.
- Experience in aquatics programs desired
- American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certification
- American Red Cross WSI Certification
- Ability to secure certification prior to employment in:  
**Mandatory:** Standard First Aid, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Blood Borne Pathogens
- Must work flexible hours (summer season runs June- end of August)
- Must be available to work the entire season.
- Required to teach swimming lessons
- Attend mandatory training session in Emergency Water Safety and water testing
