JOB SUMMARY

Under supervision of head guard. Required to safeguard wading pool patrons and ensure proper use of wading pool and facilities. Other duties include maintenance of the pool and surrounding areas.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- *Is considered a first responder for all medical emergency procedures and may be exposed to possible health risks. Including cleaning and supervision of aquatic facility*
- Supervise aquatic facility
- Enforce all facility rules and regulations
- Maintains pool records and paperwork
- Ability to detect potential or actual emergency conditions and handle them safely and effectively
- Ability to foster good public relations with the local public
- Must be able to instruct learn to swim program.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS

- 16 years of age or older.
- Experience in aquatics programs desired
- American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certification
- American Red Cross WSI Certification
- Ability to secure certification prior to employment in:
 - Mandatory: Standard First Aid, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Blood Borne Pathogens
- Must work flexible hours.
- Required to teach swimming lessons
- Attend mandatory training session in Emergency Water Safety and water testing
